It is an exciting time to join Frontier's Finance Department - we are poised for growth across all lines of business and our financial capacity must increase to match. The new Director has the opportunity to oversee the upgrade of our current financial system into a cloud-based platform, perform ongoing analysis of all lines of business, and participate in high-level strategy and goal-setting discussions with other senior staff and Frontier's board of directors.

Goals for the position in the first year include:

- Assist in creating a company budget that sets goals for productivity and aligns with Frontier's strategic plan
- Help to create goals that increase the size of Frontier's balance sheet

- Transition Frontier's accounting software and processes to a cloud-based platform

- Have a degree in Accounting
- Be proficient in accounting software (experience with MIP is a plus)
- Be proficient in Microsoft Office
- Have excellent oral and written communication skills
- Have outstanding interpersonal and leadership skills

- Feels kinship with Appalachia
